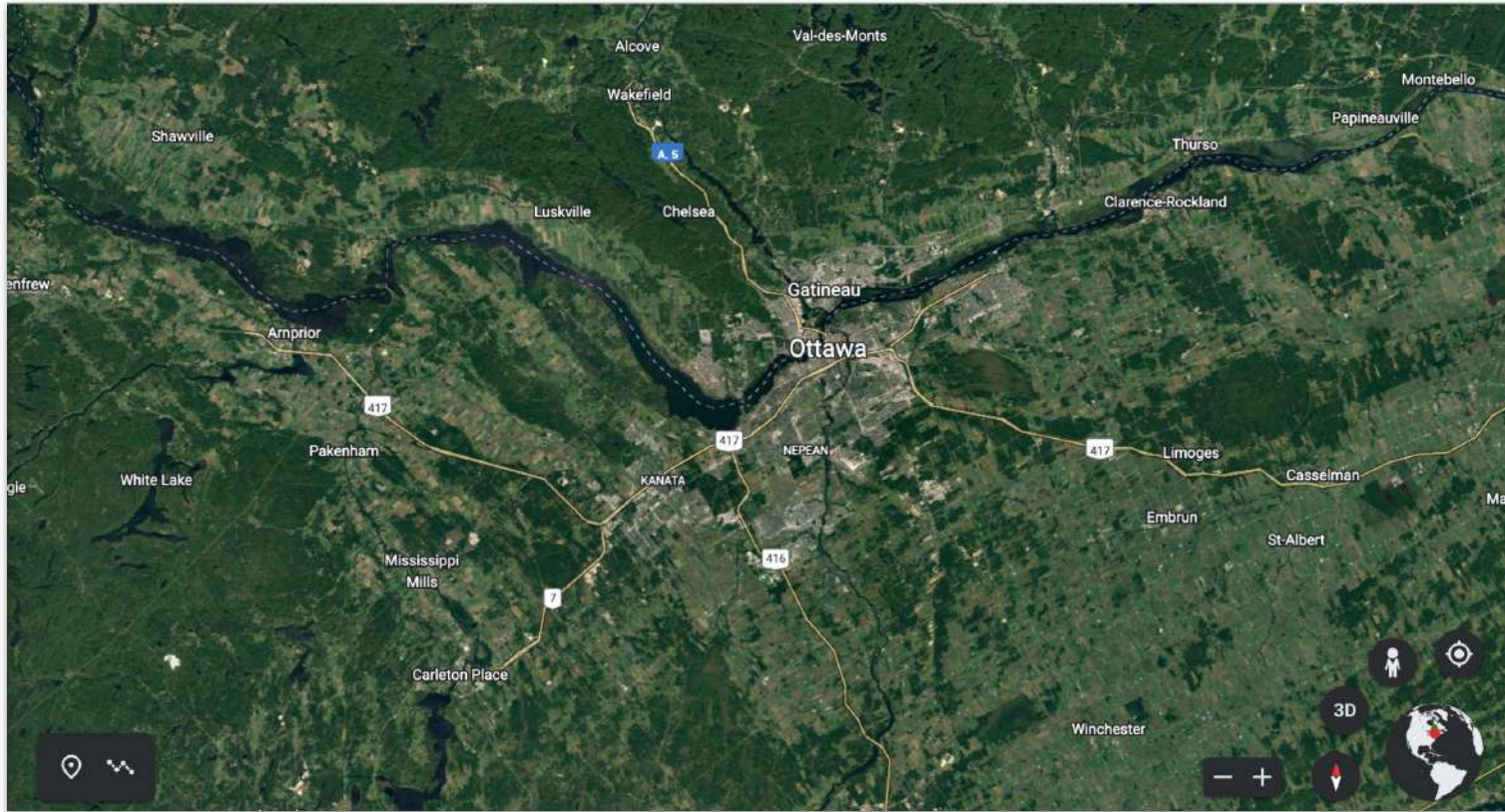

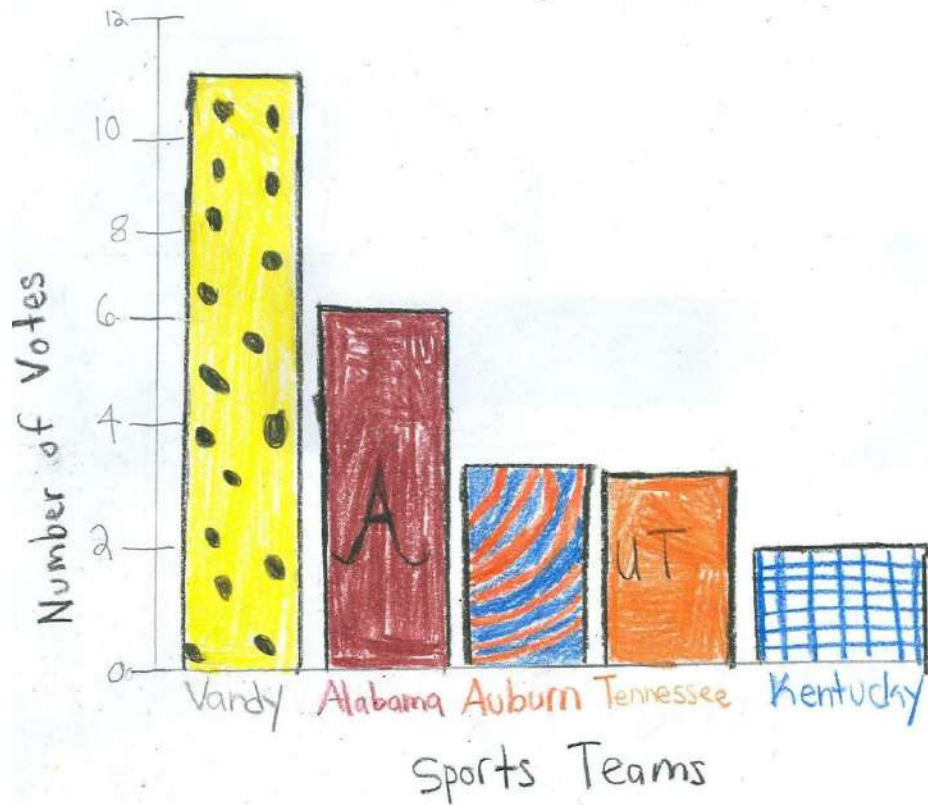
## Newfoundland and Labrador: Rain

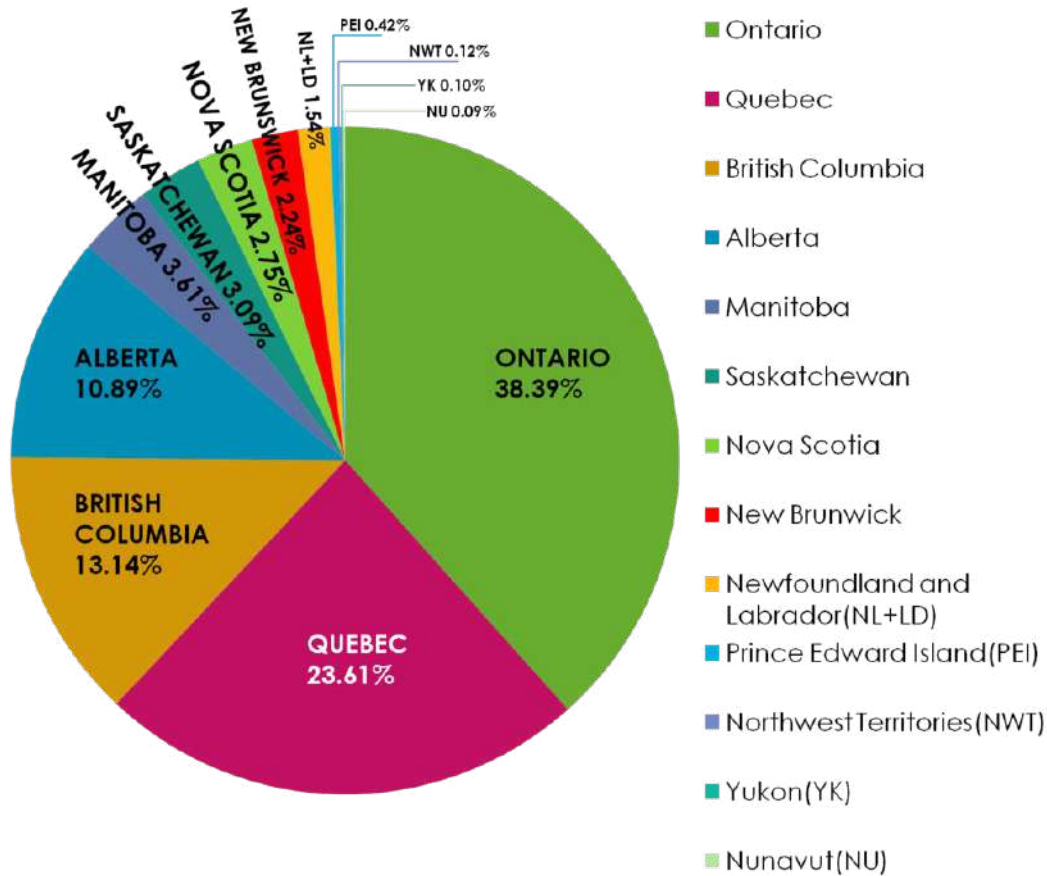

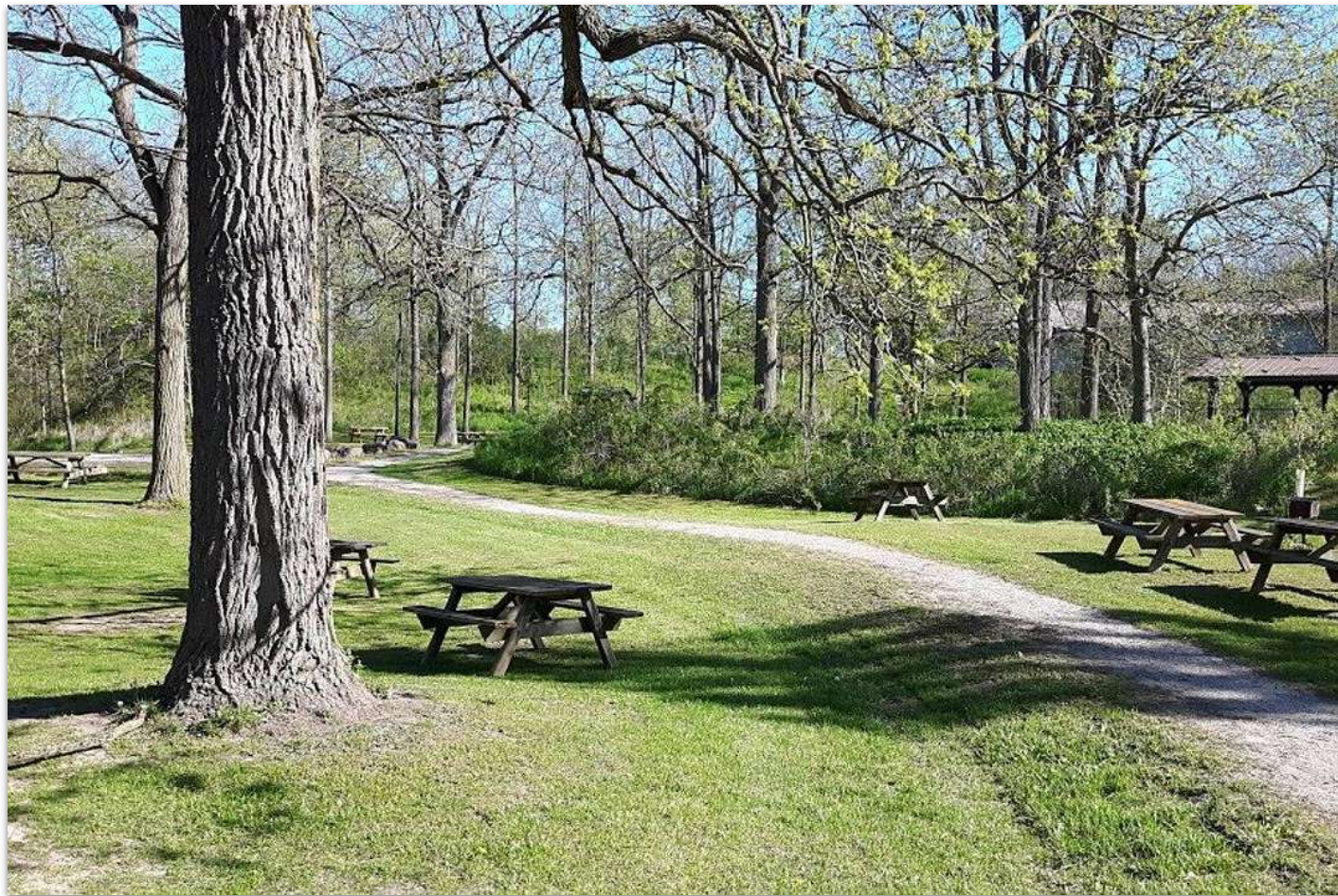

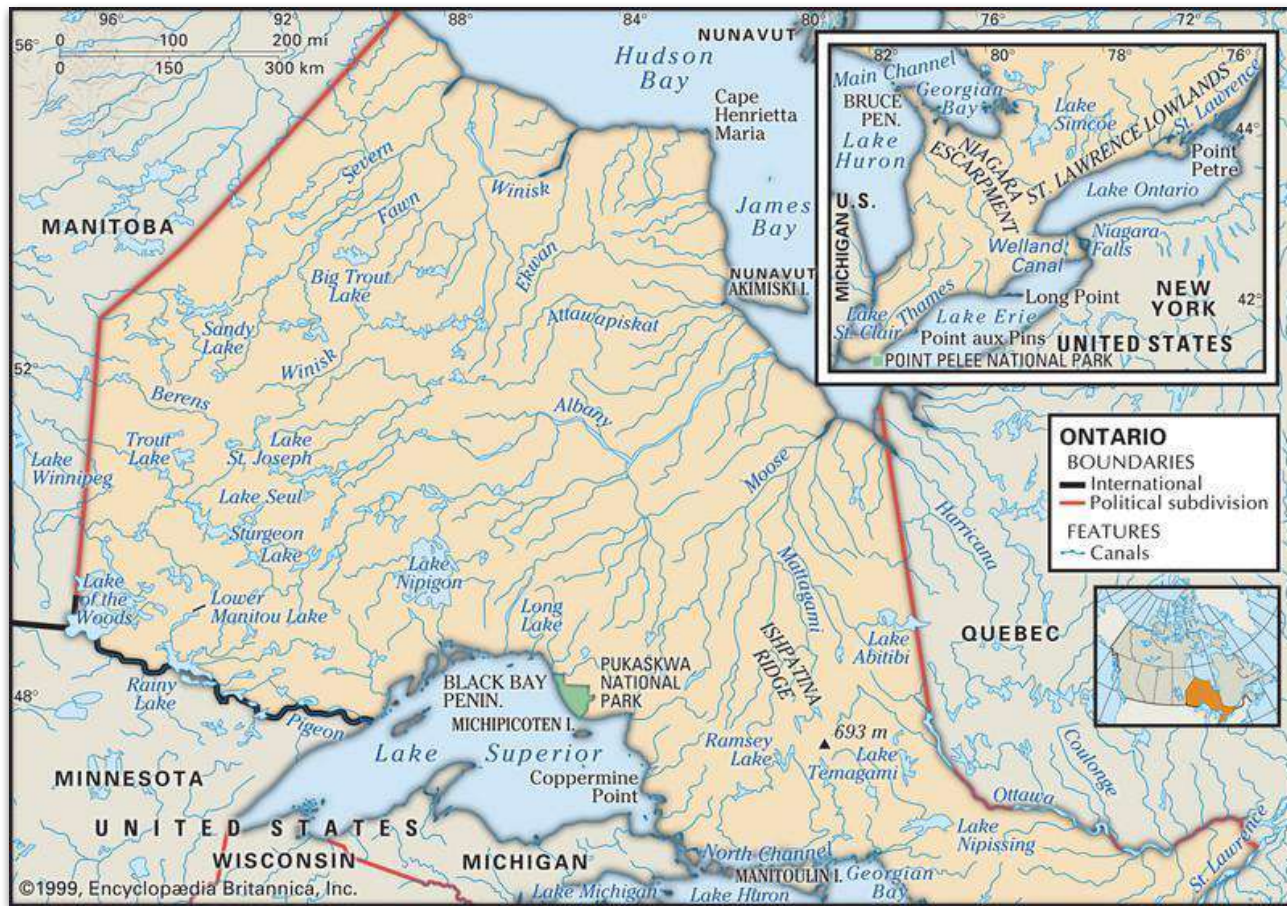
